Environmental Education

• Analysis of the meaning 'healthy diet' and relate it to pupils' personal choices.

- Suggestion of ways in which pupils can improve their choices in relation to food.
- Enjoy the preparation of a healthy breakfast and adopt such attitudes that promote a healthy way of life.

ICT

Curriculum unit: Creating movies, Power Point presentations, Excel worksheets, newsletters, posters and crafts.

- Creation of short movies about school activities related to waste management (visit to the supermarket, interviewing customers, preparing a healthy breakfast, creating crafts).
